29.01 Authority.

This ordinance is adopted pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 66.1001.

29.02 Comprehensive Plan Adopted.

The Manitowoc County 20-Year Comprehensive Plan dated December 7, 2009 is hereby adopted and may be referred to as the Comprehensive Plan.

29.03 Delivery.

The County Clerk shall send a copy of the Comprehensive Plan to each of the following:

- (1) Every governmental body that is located in whole or in part within the boundaries of Manitowoc County;
- (2) The clerk of every local governmental unit that is adjacent to Manitowoc County;
- (3) The Wisconsin Land Council;
- (4) The Wisconsin Department of Administration;
- (5) The Bay-Lake Regional Planning Commission; and
- (6) Each public library that serves Manitowoc County.

29.04 Severability.

The provisions of this ordinance and the Comprehensive Plan are severable. If any part of this ordinance or the Comprehensive Plan is found to be invalid, unlawful, or unenforceable, that finding will not affect the validity, lawfulness, or enforceability of the remainder of this

ordinance or the Comprehensive Plan, and the remainder of this ordinance and the Comprehensive Plan shall remain in full force and effect.

29.05 Relation to Other Ordinances.

If a provision of any other ordinance is in conflict with a provision of this ordinance or the Comprehensive Plan, the provisions of this ordinance and the Comprehensive Plan are controlling.
